**Elijah isn't the type of person that would stick out much:** He's pretty average all around and has never really strived for anything meaningful, therefore hasn't learned much about who he is, leaving him feeling incomplete and wasted, but doesn't know why.

It isn't entirely his fault, though. **In the nowhere town he's originally from, there wasn't much opportunity,** yet, his mother, Cynthia, always kept the family residing there, despite it being so far from her work at the *UEIE*.

**Elijah always took his mother's word because, strangely, she was the only one who could provide any kind of emotional security.** Now that she's gone, Elijah, his father, and his sister pack up and set off to NexCity.

Without his mom, Elijah is even more distressed than before, but tries to carry whatever knowledge he was given by her. **He may not know it, but his voice is a powerful tool, an asset necessary to inspire his allies, and even himself.**

**He's come to enjoy photography and painting, he has a weird obsession with horses and has always wanted to try equestrianism, and has fostered a duty to nurture others. He thinks out loud and is very awkward. How would someone like him work in a chaotic place like NexCity!?**



**Luna takes charge** and does it well, knowing how to build a proper strategy for anything. That's thanks to her **sporty childhood, namely soccer and volleyball**. She's a total powerhouse, or at least she appears to be.

Under the surface, **Luna is actually really lonely and ashamed**. Growing up, her negative emotions weren't understood and **she discovered her dark magic abilities early in age, comparing herself to Earth's interdimensional adversaries, she closed herself off from everyone and hid herself**.

As time passed, **she grew increasingly more disdainful for herself**. Her athleticism may just be an outlet for her aggression, but how long can so much pressure withstand without being properly addressed?

Whenever Luna isn't sleeping, **she can be found in the mess of her room rotting her brain away with video games, she tends to procrastinate, but can produce beauties under immense pressure, and finds the slightest comfort in sitting on the edge of the NexCity Bridge and dipping her feet in the stream**.

Elijah and Luna may seem like an odd pair at first glance, but in most ways, **they complement each other quite well.** Lost without his mother's perfect guidance, **Elijah's lack of direction and emotional confusion find solace in Luna's decisive nature, strength, and strategic thinking.** With Luna battling her own inner demons, **Elijah's weapon of tongue is something Luna values greatly, even if she may not know how to express it.** Despite their individual weaknesses, **they find strength in each other's company.** **Elijah's openness and willingness to speak his thoughts out loud help Luna confront her own insecurities,** while **Luna's practicality and determination push Elijah to find himself.** Together, they form a unique bond where **each relies on the other's strengths to navigate the internal and external challenges they face in and out of their worlds.**





Cassie is a Puerto Rican teen from PreCity. Without negative emotions, she can be very steadfast and has impetuous tendencies, making her and Elijah's rambunctious younger sister, Erica, a literal explosive duo when they're around each other. She's very clumsy, so don't trust her to hold anything valuable. She is the unknowing host of the Crown Chakra, getting her entangled with Elijah and Luna and the war between dimensions.



Engel, aka "Golden Boy", is an Angel part of the Divine Council. He is considered a prodigy of his time, becoming an efficient soldier at an early age and being appointed to the Council at age 17. He has successfully led several missions on the battlefield. Though he should be a busy body governing the affairs of the many dimensions the Council controls, he spends most of his time training the youth at their institution, doing it all with a smile.



Legna, aka "Dark Boy", is an ex-soldier from the Demon Empire who has taken refuge with the Divine Council. Being an orphan with no significant binds to the Empire, he fled his home with ease. He tries to pay his "debt" to the Council for taking him in by training students at the institution with Engel, but he doesn't get paid much attention. No matter how hard he tries, he is not personable at all, and simply has given up being such. He hates that he's been given the monicker "Dark Boy", but rolls with it since it seems like no one can remember his real name anyway.






Lailyn is a member of a royal family within the Empire. With her genius intellect, Lailyn works as a scientist and engineer and is the head of the operations unit, producing military and societal advancements. She's considered their golden child. But Lailyn seeks a way out. She and her girlfriend's forbidden love puts them both in danger. With her ties to the family, eyes are constantly on her, adding extra difficulty on her many attempts to escape. When all hopes seems lost, she finds Elijah and Luna to be her ticket out.





In this universe, there exists several thousand dimensions, big and small, being dubbed the "multi-mensions". These dimensions inhabit their own species and can even exist with their own set of rules. **Matter is created when light and dark energy collide.** Measuring the ratios of energy involved in the formation of a dimension is how they can be classified: ***Aether* dimensions have more light energy than dark, allowing the life to control light magic,** and ***Nether* dimensions are made with more dark energy than light, allowing the life to control dark magic.** However, **the seven Earths are a class of their own.** Made with equal light and dark energy, **the life there cannot innately manipulate light or dark magic.**



# The 7 Chakras

The chakras are crucial to balancing the universe under the weight of immense energy and embodies a human host from each respective Earth. They allow the user to control their life energy through one of the 7 chakra variations, giving them abilities outside the scope of ordinary magic. These hosts have reincarnated all throughout history, often being unknown to the host.

# The Catalyst Gods' Reign

Long ago, powerful titan-like Gods made of sentient light and dark energy stalked the multi-mensions. Their ruling and exploration was responsible for the development of the dimensional map, and even the life that existed, influencing their languages and faiths. Their disputes quickly escalated into full scale war in Dimension Z, having residual effects on the other dimensions, leaving them in turmoil for centuries to come, some even collapsing in on themselves. At the height of the war, *Brahma* was created. It is unclear how or why Brahma came to be by the Tree, but his power was unlike anything seen before, as **he had the unique ability of controlling both light and dark energy, unlocking unimaginable magic.** For this, he was deemed an enemy of both sides, and was forced to seek refuge on other dimensions. 

# Vishnu



A mysterious individual appears donning a suit of armor and mask resembling a God. With their ominous presence, seeming omnipotence, and unrivaled magic ability, combining both light and dark, **Vishnu has been hailed as the strongest since the reign of the Gods. They're not an ally or enemy to anyone, but has taken control of the Demon Empire**, bidding them to conduct a plan that they can't carry out on their own: **To claim the 7 amulets hidden on the Earths, 7 human chakra hosts, and, finally, Elijah and Luna.** Though trust isn't fully gained between the Empire and Vishnu, they agree to work with each other to get what they want.



# Elijah's Series Arc

**Elijah starts the series conflicted about his purpose**, lacking direction and emotional security after the loss of his mother. **He finds solace in Luna's decisive nature and strength, forming a unique bond with her.**

Elijah's reliance on Luna **mirrors the connection he felt with his mother, leading to an unhealthy co-dependency.** He leans on Luna for emotional support and guidance, **struggling to find his own identity without her.**

**Upon discovering the barbaric truth of UEIE's actions, the interdimensional war, and the origin of his and Luna's magic,** Elijah initially **believes in keeping things secret**, reflecting his uncertainty and fear of taking responsibility. He struggles with the weight of this newfound knowledge and its implications for their world, **clashing with the ideals of Luna.**

Over time, **Elijah comes to realize that taking responsibility is crucial for moving forward.** He learns that keeping secrets only perpetuates harm and that by acknowledging the truth, they can work towards resolving the conflict and creating a better future for the multi-mensions.

# Luna's Series Arc



**Luna presents herself as a strong and decisive individual, but underneath the surface, she harbors feelings of loneliness and shame.** Her tendency to lead stems from a desire for control in her life, which she lacks due to her past experiences with her dark magic abilities.

**Luna struggles with allowing others to lead,** fearing vulnerability. Her athletic pursuits serve as outlets for her aggression, but she avoids addressing her emotional turmoil.

**Upon discovering the truth about UEIE's war crimes and the origin of her and Elijah's magic, Luna's beliefs about good and evil are challenged as she questions Brahma's true philosophy.** She is determined to expose UEIE and seeks justice for their actions, fueled by her comparison of herself to Semons and her belief in predetermined destiny.

**At the climax of her inner conflicts, Luna briefly aligns herself with Vishnu, drawn to their power and the promise of control over her destiny.** She questions her beliefs about her fate and grapples with the allure of power versus her moral compass.

Through her journey, **Luna learns that her life is hers to control, not dictated by external circumstances or forces.** She begins to embrace the idea that she can shape her own destiny and find fulfillment in taking ownership of her choices and actions.

Luna **confronts the mental barriers she has placed on herself, including feelings of shame and inadequacy.** She learns to embrace her vulnerabilities and imperfections, finding courage in confronting her inner demons and accepting herself fully whilst **learning the how to take the backseat and allow others to lead, supporting instead of being in the forefront.**

Once she lets go of the façade of unwavering strength, **she becomes in touch with her authentic self, allowing for deeper connections and a true sense of strength.**

# 1. Pilot

Elijah gazes out the window of the family minivan as he, his father, and sister Erica cruises through the illustrious and grand Nexcity. It's been two years since his mother's death after a voyage to another dimension with the UEIE organization ended in catastrophe. Elijah is visibly reluctant about this change, but there was no use in trying to stop it as he was the only person who could feel negative emotions; no one could understand what felt.

The three begin to unload into their new home upon their arrival when Elijah spots his next door neighbor through her window. He is suddenly surged with strength as the heavy box he was lifting became light as a feather, causing him to lift it in the air and drop it on himself. He believes he may have slipped and brushes the incident off, not even questioning how he came out uninjured.

Once things are settled in the house, the family briefs momentarily about what the next steps would look like for them, before they are interrupted by a knock at the door. Erica, who is very boisterous, jumps to answer the door. Before her stood two agents of the UEIE dressed tuxes with an Earth crest embroidered on the right chest. They presented her with a pamphlet, a welcome card, and an invitation. For every new resident, the city holds a celebration in the Nexus Square for all to come. Dad and Erica excitedly accepts, while Elijah ponders how they got to them so quickly.

Later that night, the ceremony is complete with decorations, games, food, music, and loads of people welcoming Elijah and his family to the city. Weirdered out by all the extravagance, Elijah ducks off and explores on his own, while also trying to investigate the UEIE a bit. He sees his neighbor from earlier seemingly with the same idea as himself and he decides to follow her. Having trespassed through a hole in a gate and finding himself in the small woods, he loses sight of her. That's when she jumps from nowhere and crashes into him, causing both of them to land on the ground. The girl frantically picks herself and Elijah up, grabbing his arm to run with her. Once she takes them to a place to hide, the two, still clearly panicked, realize they're both feeling the same thing, but can't describe the emotion all too well. She says her name is Luna and that she ran into a malicious creature from another world. At that moment, heavy, almost mechanical footsteps approach them, and they are discovered in their burrow. At the moment it pounces at them, Elijah and Luna both eject light and dark energy, stunning the beast.

They head to the ceremony without any time to think as the beast stands on its four feet again. They spill into the crowd of people, causing destruction. Several UEIE agents swoop in, detaining the beast. Though Elijah and Luna have been scarred, the crowd seemed to enjoy the climatic events of fair, making it the best one yet.

Elijah and Luna look to each other in disbelief that they found someone just like themselves.

## 2. Storms

A thunderstorm violently rages and the UEIE advises all residents stay indoors. Luna is over Elijah's house helping the family go through a box of Cynthia's old work belongings that had been dropped off. They find mostly old trinkets, accessories, and paperwork. At the bottom is a device with a note from the UEIE on it.

***"As another welcoming gift, we'd like you to have this artifact dating back centuries. We have no idea what it is, but it's been long deactivated. Completely harmless!"*** It was a cylindrical tool with openings on both ends. Everyone crowds around inspecting it. Everyone places their hands on it, when it begins to glow and shoots a beam out of both ends, hitting Elijah and Erica. They are suddenly transformed into one another.

Erica, now as Elijah, is completely amazed, while Elijah, now as Erica, couldn't be anymore disgusted. Elijah (as Erica) soon realizes that even in his sister's body, he still has his powers, something Elijah and Luna had before decided to keep secret for now. Nevertheless, he was desperate to resolve their issue, ignoring the UEIE's guidelines as he rushes everyone to the headquarters. The storm is extremely dangerous, but they carry on anyway.

At the UEIE, they are met with Captain Barnes, an older white fellow with a pot belly and balding head. After explaining the situation, Barnes has his agents test the device to figure out how it is activated, meanwhile he talks with the family. He mentions how destructive storm outside is a result of a leak from the Catalyst Tree interfering with the nature of the multi-dimensions, explaining how things are made up of different collisions of light and dark. Two years ago, he led a mission to Dimension Z to try and patch the Tree, as many in the past have tried, but the Tree's immense power serves as an impregnable barrier. The mission ended in disaster as they lost many, including Cynthia. Elijah is haunted by details of his mother's death. After the conversation, Elijah and Luna are able to deduce how the device was activated: By them.

They steal the device back and return home. Luna has everyone place their hand on it to cover up that Elijah and Luna are the only actually controlling it. Elijah and Erica are able to swap bodies again. Elijah has an epiphany. He takes Luna to his room where he retells how after swapping bodies, he found it weird that he still had his magic. Barnes told them how different collisions of light and dark are how things exist, including physiology. Elijah then concludes that the device didn't actually swap him and Erica's bodies, but copied the others DNA to literally transform into the other. For Elijah to still have his powers after that could only mean one thing: Their powers are not a part of their DNA.

Elijah and Luna come to realize that their magic was endowed to them by something, or someone...

# 3. While Summer Lasts

The summer is flying away. With little time left, Luna feels as though she and Elijah haven't gotten to enjoy the true experience of summer time amidst all their research before the school year starts back up. Wanting to take a little break, she invites Elijah and kick it with her older brother Louis and his friends, a crew that really knows how to have fun.

Louis and the gang were the epitome of what it means to be from Nexcity: Completely chaotic. They all spent the next few days raving, pranking, stealing, smoking, and getting into mischief. Elijah was pushing limits, but found himself enjoying the rush. Luna informed him this is everyday life here all because they have no negative emotions, nothing to fear.

Louis and the gang wanted to know more about Elijah and Luna's encounter during the celebration. After hearing all the details, they propose they go back later that night and stake out the woods. Ever since the ceremony incident, UEIE agents have been patrolling the area, so they'll need to bypass them too. Elijah is hesitant, but Luna assures him an occurrence like that won't happen so soon again anyway.

Later that night, the squad arrives at the start of the woods, careful not to alert anyone. But strangely, no one appears to be on patrol as they should. Without questioning it, they take the chance to explore. As they travel deeper, they find several unconscious agents and large foot prints. It is at this moment they overhear a voice, prompting them to investigate. Peeking out from bushes, the squad spots a young soldier standing beside a massive tank of a guard. The soldier is speaking into a device on his arm. "***This is Lieutenant Darren reporting in, the area has been controlled. Acquisition of the host can now begin. Elijah and Luna immediately try to turn back and get help, but Louis and the others have a different plan. They were getting what they came there for, a fight.

Elijah and Luna try to quietly urge them to turn around, but it was hopeless. It was at this moment, Luna ejects a wave of dark energy and consumes the area, projecting her fear onto everyone, including the Demons. Louis and the others are stunned by the overwhelming feeling. Darren and his guard go in for a deadly assault. Elijah creates a ball of light, blinding everyone in the area temporarily and everyone begins to flee. The guard casts an invisible barrier surrounding the woods, preventing them from escaping. With no way out, Elijah and Luna are forced to explain everything to the others and use what very little they've learned about creating magic to fight back. Louis and his friends, still riddled with fear, stand behind Elijah and Luna, as they fight. Their efforts are futile however, as they are captured rather quickly in a magic bubble restricting their movement. Realizing they are Humans with magic, Lieutenant Darren is intrigued by them. At this time, UEIE agents can be heard marching in their direction after breaking down the barrier.

With the mission compromised, Darren and his guard are forced to return to their dimension, taking Elijah and Luna with them.

# 4. One Way Out

Lieutenant Darren and his guard steps out the portal, with Elijah and Luna still restrained in a bubble. He's extremely frustrated with the mission's failure, concerned about what the emperors would do. He frees Elijah and Luna to question them. The two remain silent until Darren turns his back. Luna takes the opportunity to strike, punching him with her fist shrouded with dark energy, sending him flying. Luna grabs Elijah to run.

An alarm sounds as a warning to capture Elijah and Luna. They find themselves running through an extremely large facility, unable to find an exit, making sure to avoid Demon soldiers. They end up getting separate, but doors and hidden passages seem to open for them when they need it as it guides them to the outdoors, where they find each other again.

Once outside, Elijah and Luna find themselves in an extremely cold environment, appearing dark, bleak, and ominous. They run through the city, to find a safe place to settle until help can hopefully arrive. They find a tiny cavern in which they can hide in, Elijah uses a bit of magic to light a small fire. They try to collect their thoughts despite their intense spiraling. They realize that they need a portal gun and the coordinates in order to get back to their dimension. A portal gun that they'll need from the facility. The only way out of that dimension is to go through.

Elijah and Luna mentally prepare themselves to face an army on their own as it's their only choice if they want to escape. They use bits of magic to distract guards and find their way to an armory. Still, hidden doors seem to open for them as they venture through, almost as if they're being helped. Eventually, they find themselves in an arsenal of weaponry. There a woman stands. Elijah and Luna are on guard before she diffuses the situation. She introduces herself as Lailyn, a scientist and engineer responsible for the development of all the gadgets they see before them. She reveals she's been guiding Elijah and Luna to bring them to her. She explains her longing to leave her life in the Empire, but can't due to the traceable ties she has to a royal family. Lailyn agrees to help them escape and in return they'll devise a plan to free Lailyn, keeping in touch through an interdimensional paging device. She informs them about the plan the Empire have been conspiring to collect 7 chakra hosts from the Earths. She provides them with the tools they need, and Elijah and Luna are prepared to leave, but they can't just yet. Lailyn explains how opening a portal where they are could send them anywhere on their Earth. A portal will take you to the location with the most similar frequency to where you opened it. They have to make their way back to where they first came.

Lailyn helps as much as she can while Elijah and Luna rush through the facility without any concern for stealth. With soldiers pursuing them, Elijah and Luna fight back with the weapons they've been given until they finally reach the starting point. They open a portal and jump through, ending up back in the woods. UEIE soldiers come to their aid. Elijah and Luna explain everything.

Impressed with two teens' return from the Empire, the UEIE offers Elijah and Luna a place in their ranks, to which they decline as they still want to learn more about their powers first, still leaving the offer on the table.

# 5. Dreams

Luna dreams of herself in a seemingly endless open field of flowers, the sun beaming brightly and with no one else in sight. As she explores, dark clouds form in the sky that begin to follow her. She starts to run, but the clouds are gaining on her. Luna trips and turns to see a face jump out at her.

Cassie wakes out her sleep in the middle of the night, revealing the dream may have actually been hers, too. However, she immediately turns back over and goes into an open mouth snore.

In the morning, it's the first day back to school, however, Luna was unable to get any sleep last night. When she meets Elijah between their houses, Elijah notices how visibly restless she is. Luna tells him she was too excited to get any sleep, and briefly mentioned her dream, leaving out how it ended. Elijah reveals that he too had a dream of an open field of flowers. Luna questions how his ended, to where Elijah says he had just woken up.

Pondering what implications her version of the dream could've had, she proposes her and Elijah should mesh their dreams later that night using foil wrapped around their heads as they do in movies. They go about the school day watching wild antics ensue and even getting caught in a few. Luna is inactive mostly from her deprived sleep.

Luna is over Elijah's home late that night to do as they planned. They watched a movie on dream meshing to perfect it. Once they are asleep, they find themselves in the same field of flowers, but this time with each other. Luna anticipates the clouds, but they don't appear as early as they did before. That is when Cassie pops up before them. Luna has her guard up as she and Elijah question her about what all of this is, to which Cassie is just as clueless. Realizing she's not a threat, they introduce themselves. At that moment, the dark clouds appear, pursuing the group. They run for what seems an eternity, until eventually reaching an end that unveils a large, shared mindscape.
