SIMILARITIES ACROSS WORK

- Typeface: bold, clean, sans-serif fonts that enhance readability while contributing to a modern and approachable aesthetic.
- Colors: strong, contrasting colors, sometimes with a focus on black and white to provide a bold visual impact; plays with the contrast between vibrant hues and neutral tones to draw attention to important elements
- Framing: clean and structured, uses simple borders or geometric shapes to contain elements within the layout
- Style of Graphic: minimalist, yet expressive; mixes of geometric and organic shapes with a combination of straight lines, curves, and asymmetry
- Positioning of Content: deliberate and clear with grid-based layouts, but also plays with asymmetry in some works
- Overall Style: blends modernist principles with a personal, artistic flair; embraces the use of space to give content room to breathe, allowing for a clear focus on key elements; combines simplicity with expressive details to balance form and function

- intesnive farming

- parasites

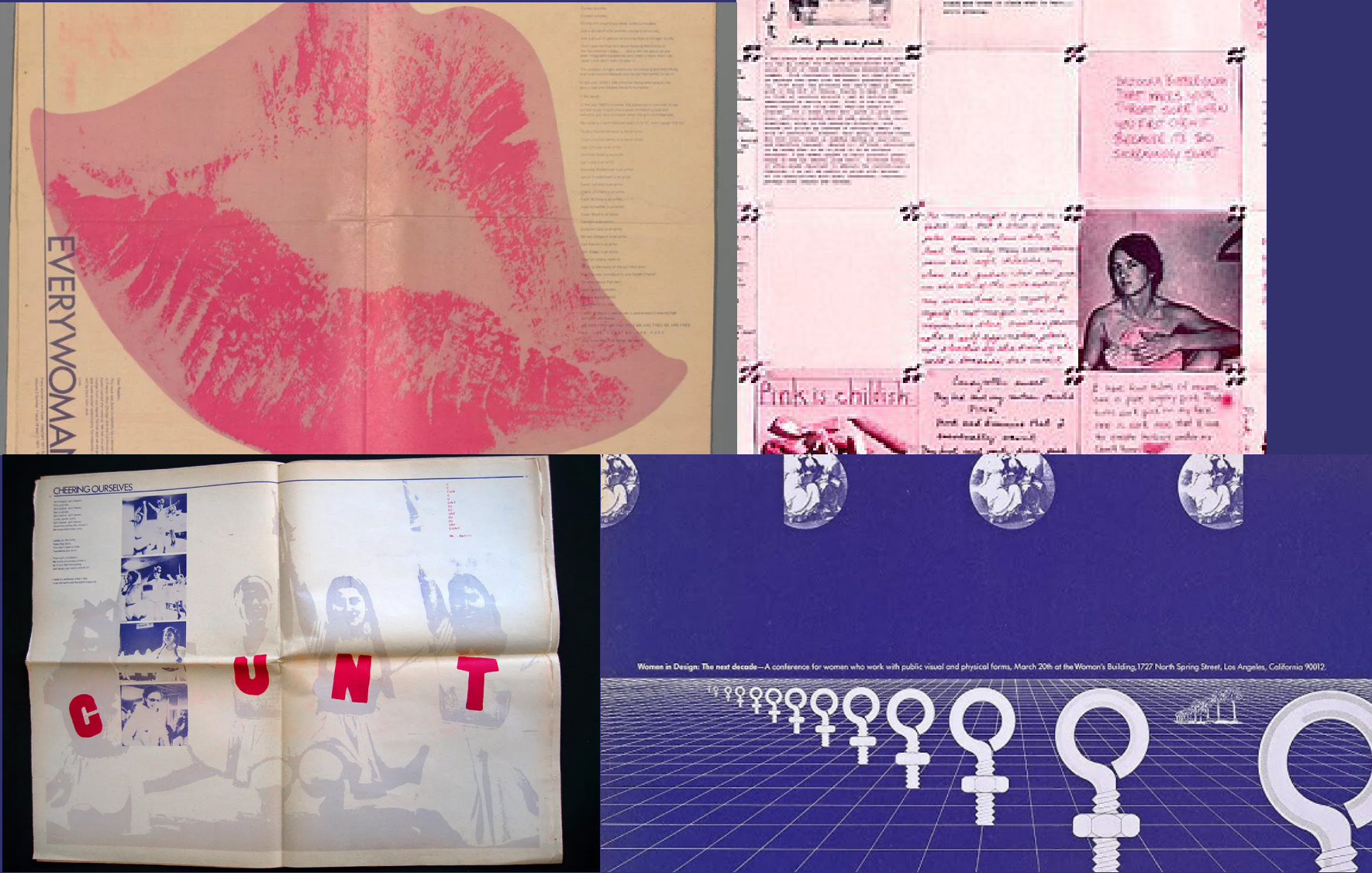
How to keep population

- make yard honey bee friendly with flower or tree species (like crocus, sweet alyssum, sunflowers, geranium, bee balm, poppies, clover or apple trees, etc)
- diet changes to organic food without use of pesticides and buy honey
- avoid using insecticides on lawns and check if toxic to bees before using
- avoid killing bees
