***Research Interests***

My primary research area is the assessment and treatment of aggressive and self-aggressive behavior. This includes the development of cognitive-behavioral interventions for disorders in which aggressive and / or self-harming (i.e. non-suicidal self-injury and/or suicidal thoughts and behaviors) symptoms are prominent (i.e. Intermittent Explosive Disorder, Borderline Personality Disorder). This also includes experimental psychopathology research on

the social, affective, cognitive and underlying neural mechanisms associated with the facilitation and inhibition of aggression and self-harm. To this end, I am involved in the development of a laboratory analogue of NSSI, as well as affective neuroscience studies of aggression and self-harm.
