## **General Instructions**

- ♦ Ensure camera lens clean. Use Lenspen.
- Ensure patient is comfortable. Adjust table, chair and chin rest height as needed
- Ensure photography room is completely dark. Reduce brightness of monitors, close doors, and close window coverings.
- If the patient cannot see the fixation light press the Set button to make the internal fixation light blink.
- (For non-mydriatic photography) Wait sufficient time between photos for the pupil to recover naturally to achieve good quality photographs. Alternate between the right and left eye.

## **Photography Procedure**

**Right field 1:** Move the stage to your left; Press FIX TARGET button to the left; Instruct patient to look to their left to center the optic disc; Capture **Left field 1:** Move the stage to your right; Press FIX TARGET button to the right; Instruct patient to look to their right to center the optic disc; Capture

**Right field 2:** Move the stage to your left; Press FIX TARGET button to the right; Instruct patient to look forward to center the macula; Capture **Left field 2:** Move the stage to your right; Press FIX TARGET button to the left; Instruct patient to

look forward to center the macula; Capture
