Submissions Deadline: Monday, October 23, 2023, noon ET

PSA CONTEST DETAILS:

Students can submit short (30 seconds), creative, and informative videos about explaining a cybersecurity or privacy problem and specific actions people can take to protect themselves online and safeguard their devices and personal data.

2023 THEMES:

- Tax scams
- Privacy and/or surveillance
- Deepfakes and/or disinformation
- E-waste recycling
- Using open-access networks safely (https, ad blockers, spoofing, VPNs)
- Cyberhygiene for small businesses

ELIGIBILITY:

- Open to any/all high school and college students across the U.S.
- Must be U.S. citizens/permanent residents.
- Students must be from the same school for group submissions.
- Multiple submissions are allowed from the same school, but there must be no overlap in membership across submissions.
- While there is no limit to team size, please note that the prize monies will be distributed evenly across all members.
